Sneaky Republican Politician Carolyn Timmann didn't tell voters in 2020 that she signed a contract on January 13, 2020, to retire on January 31, 2025, when Carolyn Timmann will collect a \$429,129 pension cash bonus (form below). But Carolyn Timmann is not going to retire on January 31, 2025. Timmann will either accept her \$429,129 pension cash bonus or apply for an \$738,000 eight year pension bonus.

Florida Politicians can apply for special permission to collect a pension cash bonus and break their contract promise retire which every other Public Employees must do as a condition to collect a pension.cash bonus.

As a **Cherry on the top**, Carolyn Timmann first started working for the Clerk's office in 2013 and will be cashing out possibly 15 years or more of unused vacation, sick and personal days at her highest pay, not the pay when days off were earned—taking more money from Taxpayers and artificially boosting her final year's pay on which Carolyn Timmann's pension is based on.

The average Martin County Resident makes \$20 an hour \$41,691 a year³ and must work over 10 years to make Carolyn Timmann's Retirement Cash Bonus of \$429,129 and work over 17.5 years to make Timmann's expected \$736,000 pension cash bonus.

Will Carolyn Timmann promise, in writing not to apply for a 8 year pension cash bonus of over \$738,000 an be satisfied with her \$429,129 Pension Cash bonus? How much, if any of Carolyn Timmann's taxpayer paid pension will she promise, in writing to donate to charity?

Resignation From Employment to Participate in the DROP:

I elect to participate in the DROP in accordance with s 121.091(13), Florida Statutes (F.S.), as indicated below, and resign my employment on the date I terminate from the DROP. I understand that the earliest date my participation in the DROP can begin is the first date I reach normal retirement date as determined by law and that my DROP participation cannot exceed a maximum of 60 months from the date I reach my normal retirement date, although I may elect to participate for less than 60 months. Participation in the DROP does not guarantee my employment for the DROP period.

I understand that I must terminate all employment with FRS employers to receive a monthly retirement benefit and my DROP benefit under Chapter 121, F. S. Termination requirements for elected officers are different as specified in s.121.091(13)(b)4., F. S. I cannot add service, change options, change my type of retirement or elect the Investment Plan after my DROP begin date. I have read and understand the DROP Accrual and Distribution information provided with this form.
