The complaint should be filled out as follows:

2. **PERSON AGAINST WHOM COMPLAINT IS BROUGHT:**

a. "Name of Individual" -Tommy Doyle

b. "If individual is a candidates, list the office or position sought": Incumbent Supervisor of Elections, Lee County

c. "Have you filed this with the State Attorney's Office?" Check "No" and follow instructions below under "Complaint #3"

d. "Are you alleging a violation of Section 104.271(2)?" Check "No"

e. "Are you alleging a violation of Section 104.2715?" Check "No"

3. **ALLEGED VIOLATION(S):**

1. Used approximately \$300,000 of Taxpayer money to pursue and then cover-up his sexual scandal with a subordinate.

2. Persuaded and pressured his subordinate to withdraw her EEOC Sexual Harassment Complaint and quit her SOE job in exchange for Taxpayer Money.

3. Engaged in sexual relations with his subordinate on taxpayer time during office hours at the Subordinate's Condo.

4. Used taxpayer money and or Campaign money to pay for legal advice to draft the Severance Agreement and EEOC Complaint Withdraw statement.

5. The Ghost Employee used to pay the 20 payroll cycle payments to the subordinate Doyle pressured to quit her job and withdraw the EEOC Sexual Harassment Complaint

6. SOE does not have and or does not enforce a strict policy prohibiting supervisors from having a sexual or romantic relationship with subordinates.

7. Investigate if there were any other women sexually harassed by Tommy Doyle

8 Used \$2,000 of his personal money to the subordinate as an incentive to persuade and pressure her to withdraw her EEOC sexual harassment complaint and didn't report that \$2,000 as on in-kind expenditure in his campaign finance reports (Similar to what Donald Trump was convicted of).

VIOLATIONS OF FS 104.31 and 106.113: I believe Tommy Doyle has misused taxpayer funds and possibly campaign funds and likely violated Florida Statutes in pursuing and covering up a sexual affair with a subordinate employee.

I am asking for:

- ***A thorough investigation into the use of public funds to conduct this sexual relationship during taxpayer time with a subordinate and then cover up the affair.***
- ***Use of Tommy Doyle's personal funds as part of the persuasion and pressuring the subordinate to withdraw her EEOC Sexual Harassment Complaint and quit her job and failure to report that money and private or taxpayer paid legal advise to draft the narrative about why the subordinate withdrew her EEOC Sexual Harrassemnt complaint on his campaign finance reprot.***
- ***Appropriate sanctions or penalties if violations are confirmed.***
- ***Measures to prevent future misuse of public resources for electioneering purposes***
- ***Repaymment by Tommy Doyle of the approximate \$300,000 of taxpayer funds used to pruse and then cover up his sexual scandal with a subordinate.***

The [Florida Division of Ethics](#) is responsible for investigating complaints regarding ethical breaches by public officials. A complaint can be filed if the violation involves misuse of public position or resources for personal or political gain.

4. Sign completed COMPLAINT form and attach your STATEMENT OF FACT with same evidence attached as above
5. Get the COMPLAINT form NOTARIZED
